What are cookies?

Cookies are small files that are stored on your media and in which are stores certain settings and data for an exchange with the system through your browser. Some of the cookies are deleted immediately after the browser session is over (i.e., temporary or session cookies). Other cookies stay on your final device and enable us to recognize your browser at the next visit (persistent or stored cookies).

Cookie types

There are four main types of cookies:

- **Urgent Cookies:** These cookies are crucial as they allow moving through and using features of the website.
- **Functional cookies:** These cookies allow that the website remembers your choices (such as your username, language, or the region in which you are) and

gives you improved and more personal features. The information collected by these cookies, can be anonymized and cannot track your browser activity on other websites.

- **Performance cookies:** These cookies collect information about how you use the website. Execution cookies do not collect information that identifies you. All information collected by these cookies is aggregated and therefore anonymous. These information is only used to improve the functioning of the website.
- **Third-party destination or third-party advertising cookies:** These cookies are used to deliver ads that are more relevant to you and your interests. They are also used to limit the number of times each ad is shown and also to help measure the effectiveness of an advertising campaign. They remember that you visited the site and this information is forwarder to others organizations such as advertisers.

By using the websites you agree to the use of emergency cookies. Required cookies are necessary for the operation of the Website and we do not store your personal information and allow you to navigate the web site and use the features of the web pages.
